# **Kicking School Overview**

This camp is in its inaugural year for Bishop Dullaghan Football Camps. It will host young men in grades 9-12 looking to improve their skills in all phases of the kicking game. Athletes will have the opportunity to develop their knowledge and techniques in kicking, punting, and place kicking through the instruction of our coaching staff both on the field and in the film room.

The purpose of the camp is to develop football skills in all aspects of the kicking game – kicking, soccer kicking, kick offs, and holding techniques. Growth in the punting game will also be an area of focus throughout the course of the camp as well. Athletes will focus on all aspects of punting – the drop, forming the ball, leg swing, and rugby. Drills throughout the course of the camp will be filmed so each athlete will receive individual instruction on techniques and areas of improvement.

The camp will consist of 7 practice "Opportunities", spread over the course of 3 days on DePauw University's campus. Players will be housed in the university's dorms and eat in the university's dining facilities. Attending an overnight camp holds so many advantages to the "day camp" format which limits the athletes in so many ways. An overnight camps allows for 7 full practice sessions over the course of the 3 days, extra sessions in the classroom with video analysis, nightly guest speakers, and the opportunity to get a taste of a collegiate experience at one of the best universities in the Midwest. This opportunity allows for an increased level of interaction with coaches and players that will not be experienced in a "day camp" format.

This camp is focused on helping aspiring kickers and punters improve their techniques and build confidence in an experience that is both demanding and rewarding.
