Camp Overview

Going into its 45th year, the Bishop Dullaghan Football Camps are the still the preeminent skill development camps for all positions in football. With two settings to chose from, Team Camp and Individual Technique Camp, players can be developed both in large groups, and as individuals. The majority of time spent on the field is spent on individual technique work, with opportunities for competition in 1on1, 7on7, and “team” work. “Opportunities” are spread over 3 days on DePauw University’s campus. Players are housed in DePauw University dorms, and are fed in the campus dining facility. All practice opportunities occur on DePauw’s 3 state-of-the-art artificial turf fields, and classrooms are utilized between practices for film study.

The coaching staffs are composed of some of the best college and high school coaches in the Midwest, and the ratio of player-to-coach never exceeds 10 to 1. The purpose of this camp is to help football players to improve their techniques and to build their confidence in a very intense and educationally rewarding experience.
